

Asian Studies Minor Requirements

SUNY New Paltz

18 Credits

The minor provides an introduction to the study of Asian languages and culture. To students of Asian descent it also serves to provide a better appreciation of themselves and of their heritage. Students minoring in Asian Studies must receive no less than C- in any course used to satisfy the minor requirements.

LANGUAGE (8 credits): CHI/JPN 101 (4 credits) and CHI/JPN 102 (4 credits)

- One year of language study in either Chinese or Japanese. Students with language proficiency in these or other Asian languages may take 8 credits in other Asian Studies courses.

ELECTIVE COURSES (10 credits):

- Minimum 3 Credits must be completed in the culture of the language studied.
- Minimum 9 credits must be solely Asian Studies.
- Minimum 6 credits must be completed in the Upper Division courses.
- Minimum 9 credits must be completed at SUNY New Paltz
