

CRI Scoring Cheat Sheet

1. Determine which miscues are scoreable and which are non-scoreable. Use chart on p. 26 for help if needed.
 - Highlight scoreable miscues PINK
 - Highlight non-scoreable miscues YELLOW
2. Determine which **scoreable** miscues (the PINK ones) are meaning violating (MV) and which are meaning maintaining (MM). Use p. 25-26 for help if needed.
 - Write a **0** (zero) next to every *meaning violating* miscue
 - These are the miscues that would cause confusion or “mess up” the student’s comprehension of the passage.
 - Write a **+** (plus) next to every *meaning maintaining* miscue
 - These are the miscues that would NOT cause confusion or “mess up” the student’s comprehension of the passage.
3. Total the number of scoreable miscues (the PINK ones). Find that number of miscues in the Miscue Chart in the bottom right-hand corner of the Examiner’s Copy (assessment protocol) to determine the Reading Accuracy Index (RAI) and write the corresponding percentage next to *Reading Accuracy Index:_____*.
4. Total the number of scoreable, *meaning violating* miscues (the PINK ones that have **0** next to them). Find that number of miscues in the Miscue Chart to determine the Meaning Maintenance Index (MMI) and write the corresponding percentage next to *Meaning Maintenance Index_____*.
