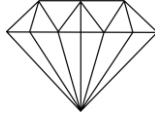
We are accepting applications until **Friday, April 21st at 11:59PM.**

- ❖ Must have been an active participant in campus community for time at New Paltz.

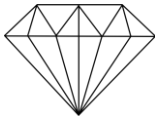
