Election

Matt: We should have 7 residence halls present, which means we have quorum so we can process. With that, I would like to have the candidates running for the RHSA Treasurer position for Spring 2021 - Spring 2022 introduce themselves.

Logan: Hi, my name is Logan Bross. My pronouns are he/him/his and I'm running for RHSA Treasurer for Spring 2021 - Spring 2022.

Matt: Logan, I will be putting you in the waiting room, but we';; invite you back when it is time for you to give your speech. I'm going to share the election materials with all of you and I will have our current Treasurer read off the duties of Treasurer.

Jess: The duties of Treasurer are:

- A. Responsible for maintaining accurate documentation of the current RHSA budget;
- B. Pays all approved expenses by following the procedure for Disbursing Orders
- (D.O.'s); (D.O.'s must be handed in within two weeks or expense will be denied reimbursement)
- C. Works alongside the current President, President-elect, and Treasurer-elect to create the budget for the following year;
- D. Works with the President to review all Funding Requests submitted to RHSA and approves or denies each request; 1. Funding Requests shall follow procedures outlined in Article 13, Section 4;
- E. Maintains communication with the CAS office:
- F. Holds a position on the CAS Board of Directors and attends monthly CAS Board meetings;
- G. Attends all President's Cabinet meetings;
- H. Maintains open communication with the Executive Board and Advisors about the current budget;
- I. Works alongside an Advisor to coordinate the Care Package program through On Campus Marketing (OCM).

Matt: That is all of the duties. We're going to have 3 minutes to come up with expectations of Treasurer and we will begin with the first x in the chat.

Expectations of Treasurer:

- Maintains organization
- Good time management
- Has experience managing money and budgets
- Willing to build a relationship with the CAS Office
- Good communication skills

- Honest and reliable
- Excel or Google Sheets skills
- Adaptability
- Good attention to detail

Matt: That is time. I will now be adding the candidate in for their speech.

Candidate 1: Logan Bross

Hi, my name is Logan Bross, my pronouns are he/him/his, and I'm running for RHSA Treasurer. I'm a junior. My major is Adolescent Education Social Studies and a minor in mathematics. My experience Hall Gov and RHSA wise is I've been an A.C. Rep for 2 semesters, I was Treasurer for 1, and the past few semesters I've been the communications coordinator. In Ridgeview, we call it President because it's just easier. I've also been living in Ridgeview for the past 4 years. I also received Clare's E-Board Choice, which is also really cool. My skills for the Treasurer position are I'm hardworking and passionate about whatever I'm doing, which I think is the most important skill to have for any of these positions. I'm super organized. I have great time management skills. I know how to use Excel. I was a former Treasurer so I have handled a budget before, I know how to document one, I know how to fill out the DO's, or Distributing Orders. I have been in a position where I've handled other people's finances before. Why I'm running for RHSA Treasurer is because over the past 3 years, this organization has given me so much and the sense of community really has helped my sense of worth in a way. It's made me feel not alone. I did not picture myself in any leadership opportunity when I was a freshman 3 and a half years ago. The fact that I am here even running for something like this has made me genuinely love helping others in any possible way I can. I feel like this is the next step for me. In order to do that, I get to be part of an E-Board that is so welcoming and community driven. It's something that I love doing. I know all of the duties of Treasurer. I don't feel as if you need me to list them because you just heard them, but if you ask me, I can list them later. I went to almost all of former Treasurer Matt's Office Hours last semester and then went to Jess' Office Hours this semester to figure out how the position has changed since the pandemic so I know I can do this. With that, I yield to questions.

Question & Answer:

Matt: We are going to have a 5 minute Q&A that is extendable up to 3 times. The time will begin with the first x in the chat.

Do you have any plans to improve relations with our sister organization, NRHH, and our other sister organization, the Student Association?

Logan: I'd love to do some sort of collaboration with them. I think a big step, for my own self to establish some sort of relationship with them, would be emailing them. I'm going to be honest, I do not have a direct plan right now, but that is something I'd be thinking about if I were to get the position,

In your opinion, what is the hardest aspect of the Treasurer position and what would you do to overcome it?

Logan: Being RHSA Treasurer is a lot different from being Hall Gov Treasurer, but the same issue has come about from what I've learned. In order for you to fill out DO's and get people the money that they need, you need to receive the sign in sheets and receipts

from people. For some reason though, that's really hard to get. You're always relying on other people to bring the materials. It seems like a simple thing to do yet, somehow, it makes no sense for people to always do that. When I was Treasurer of Hall Gov, every Treasurer report I specified that I needed the sign in sheet and receipts. I even put a folder in big bold letters in our office that said, "Put sign in sheets and receipts in here." I made a big deal about it and I would do the same as RHSA Treasurer. I would repeatedly ask for sign in sheets and receipts as some people forget to do that and without that they cannot receive their money back. That makes our life difficult as well as theirs. I would say reinforcing that to everyone, that's the hardest part.

What's a mistake that you've made in the past, how did you fix it and how would you avoid it in the future, specifically regarding treasurer?

Logan: Treasurer wise, I have not made any technical mistakes. However, I would double and triple back all my work. However, Hall Gov wise, I've had some programs completely fall through, have not worked, and had no participation. I went back and thought about what aspects of programs were popular, which aspects of them that people enjoy, and why did mine fail. Was it set up properly? After running a lot of programs, some of them work and some of them don't. That's a mistake that I reflect on and seeing how I could improve with the PR or things and such.

What's your relationship like with the CAS Office and how do you plan to strengthen it?

Logan: My relationship with the CAS Office is pretty good. It's been a while since I was Treasurer so I have not spoken to them in a while. I did go to them to get the Treasurer stuff for this semester. As Treasurer, I would reach out more to introduce myself to them by email and be in constant communication with them. Maybe, other members of E-Board could reach out to them so RHSA as a whole becomes closer to them. I would just email them a bunch, especially because we're virtual, and strengthen the relationship that way.

How do you manage time on a daily basis?

Logan: Normally what I do every week is create a weekly schedule for myself. If anything changes, I will make changes to my schedule the night before. I revolve around my classes and how much I think certain assignments will take. I do have sections of time if I need to extend on something or not because random things do happen throughout the day. I like sticking to a schedule because of some other things.

How do you hope to grow in this position?

Logan: Being Treasurer of Hall Gov does not equal being Treasurer of RHSA, obviously. It's much grander and it requires a bunch of other tasks. One thing that I hope I get better at doing is talking in front of people. For some weird reason, sometimes I have trouble with that and there's a lot of PresCab meetings and CAS Board meetings that I would have to go to. That would give me that opportunity. Also, I would like to strengthen my skills as someone who works with Excel, I know how to use Excel. I'm not a genius at Excel so I'm hoping that throughout this and managing a budget, I learn

some of those skills. Budget managing is a skill that I have, but I think it'll vary. There are a few things actually I would love to improve on through the position.

What would you bring to the Treasurer's position that would help others grow around you?

Logan: I've been told that I have a positive aura around me and it comes from a place where I like to help others. If someone comes to me with a problem of thiers, I will stop everything that involves me and help them with their problem. Sometimes, it was to the point where I'm sacrificing stuff, I've learned how to balance that out of a bit. I want to be a warm, positive person that anyone can come to and feel a sense of community through the RHSA E-Board or through these meetings to provide someone with a sense of not being alone. I hope I can do that for a lot of people while also doing the technical aspects of Treasurer. That's what I hope to bring to the E-Board.
